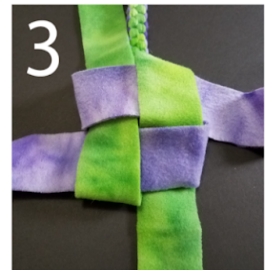


Dog Pull Toy

Supplies Included: fleece

1. Cut 4 lengths of fleece fabric. About 2" wide and 45" long is ideal for a medium-sized dog. (included)
2. Tie a regular overhand knot at one end, leaving a few inches of fabric as a tail. Pull the knot tight.
3. Tie your square knots:
 - a. Open your 4 strips into a plus sign shape.
 - b. Fold the top strip towards the bottom, a little to one side, *always the same side as you progress*.
 - c. Fold the bottom strip towards the top, a little to the other side, *always the same side as you progress*.
 - d. Fold the right strip towards the left. Pass over the first strip, then under the second.
 - e. Fold the left strip toward the right. Pass over the first strip, then under the second.
 - f. Pull all of the strips nice and tight.
4. When you've got about 5 inches left, tie off the end with another overhand knot and pull tightly.
5. Trim off tails to make them even.
6. Split each of the tails in two to make the ends a little more festive.
7. Smile a knowing smile that you are a dog-toy making genius.

Cat Toy

Supplies Included: fleece & string

1. Cut your fleece scrap so it's about 2 inches wide and 12 inches long. (included)
2. Fold the scrap in half lengthwise.
3. Make little cuts all the way down the length of the folded fleece but be sure not to cut all the way to the fold.
4. Cut a length of string (18 inches or so). (included)
5. Unfold the fleece and tightly roll it.
6. Tie the string around the middle of the roll. A double knot is a good idea.
7. Smoosh into a ball-shape.
8. Play with your cat!
