

Holiday Door Hanger

Supplies

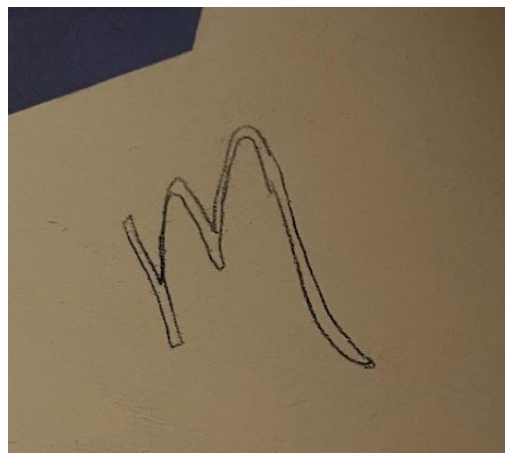
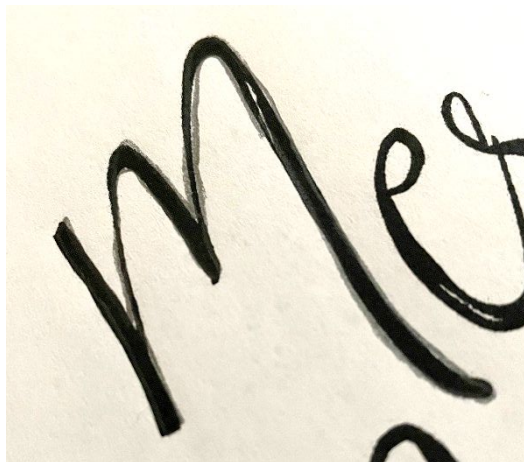
Included: wooden door hanger, paint, carbon paper, stencil

Not Included: paint brush, pencil, tape, Sharpie marker

1. Untie and take off the twine at the top. Discard the paper tag.
2. Paint the wooden door hanger. Let it dry.
3. Decide where you want your words to go and place the stencil (piece of paper with winter saying on it) on the wood. Tape down the piece of paper in a spot or two so it doesn't move around too much.
4. Slide the carbon paper between the wood and the stencil. (Note: You might have to cut the carbon paper to fit under the stencil depending where you place the winter saying.) The carbon paper should have the dark side facing the wood. Now, anything you write or trace on the stencil will be copied onto the wood.



5. Trace over the stencil with a pencil or pen. Make sure to get the outline of every letter. Don't worry about filling any of the thicker parts of letters.



Note: It can be difficult to match the stencil with your markings if you move the stencil part way through. Take care when tracing the stencil and **do it in one sitting.**

6. When done tracing, untape the stencil and remove the stencil and carbon paper. You should see the outline of the words on the wood.
7. Trace the words on the wood with a Sharpie. Fill in any thicker outlines.
8. Tie the twine back through the hole at the top.
9. Hang on your door to enjoy it for the rest of the season.
