

Marble Dipped Vase



Supplies

Included : Glass Vase, Nail Polish, Toothpick

Not Included: Container for dipping

1. Fill a bowl approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way full with warm water.
2. You will need to move quickly through this next process: Hold the bottle of nail polish close to the water's surface and drip a few drops into the water. The polish will spread once it hits the water. Drop your second color into the bowl in the same manner.
3. Using the provided toothpick, swirl the paint together before it dries on the surface. *Tip: if for some reason the polish is drying before you can make your swirl pattern, try pouring in two colors at once (one bottle in each hand).*
4. Once you have achieved your desired pattern, immediately dip the vase into the bowl, rotating the vase to pick up the paint. It is ok for the vase to go into the water, and might be the easiest way to do this. Just be careful not to tear through the paint. For a darker effect, the dipping process can be done multiple times.

5. Make any corrections that you want to your vase with nail polish remover. (If you don't like the results you can use nail polish remover and a cotton swab to remove the entire design-I did this 3 times until I was happy with the results). Turn the vase upside down and let it dry. Fill with water and flowers of your choosing.
6. Wash the vase by hand when/if necessary. ***This is not "dishwasher safe".***
