

Fabric Lined Mason Jar



Supplies

Included : Mason Jar, fabric, Mod Podge(glue)

Not Included: Small paint brush

1. Cut the fabric in strips slightly longer than the length of the jar, (3 strips should cover the walls of the jar)
2. Using a small paint brush, apply the Mod Podge to both sides of **one** strip of fabric.
3. Place the strip, printed side facing the glass, in the jar, top to bottom. Using your brush, flatten out the strip against the jar wall.
4. Complete steps 2 & 3 until the entire jar is covered with fabric (the Mod Podge will dry clear)
5. If you like, and have additional fabric you can outline the bottom of your jar, cut out the circle, apply the Mod Podge to the piece and affix it to the bottom, inside of the jar, fabric side facing down.
6. This jar can be used for many purposes. I placed an artificial floral arrangement in mine. However, please do not put liquid of any kind in the jar as that will cause the glue to soften and fabric to come loose from the jar. **ENJOY!**
