

# Mini Book Pendant



## Supplies

**Included:** 3 mini books, short string, long string, jump ring

**Not Included:** glue, scissors

1. Decide what order in which you'd like your book stack. Play with having them a little offset, so it looks like a natural stack of books.
2. Glue them together. Only a small amount of glue is needed.
3. Let them dry so they don't slip around when tying them together.
4. Once dry, tie the book stack together into a bundle. Place the small string over the top of your book stack (red book in my example).



5. Flip the stack upside down and tie a double knot (blue book).



6. Take the ends of the string and wrap them around the stack of books in the opposite direction. The strings will make a cross on the bottom book.

7. Flip the book stack over again and tie a double knot (red book). Now your books are bundled together.



8. Slide the jump ring on one of the strings and tie a double knot again to keep the ring on. Try and make it as centered on your stack of books as possible.



9. Trim the excess string leaving as much or little as you like.

10. The pendant is done!

11. Slide the pendant on the long string provided to make it a necklace or use a chain or necklace you already have and put this pendant on it.
