

Patriotic Coasters

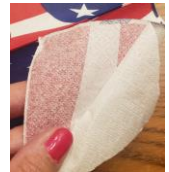


Supplies

Included : 4, 4"x4" ceramic tiles, 2-ply patriotic napkins, Mod Podge, sandpaper, felt, jute

Not Included: Scissors, small paint brush

1. Peel off the backing of the napkin. The easiest way to do this is to cut a corner of the napkin at an angle. Rub the napkin using your thumb and pointer finger until the napkin separates. Gently peel the backing off. (toss backing)
2. Cut the napkin in 4 equal pieces (5"x5" pieces). *Note: 1 napkin will yield 4 coasters, however a 2nd napkin is included for any mistakes.* Paint the entire tile, including the sides, with Mod Podge, line the napkin up with the tile and gently press it to the tile, including the sides. Use your hands to gently press out any big wrinkles... you will have some wrinkles, it's impossible to get them all out. You will also want to use your fingers to press the napkin to the sides of the tile.
3. Allow the tiles to dry, I placed mine on a cooling rack. Apply 2 more coats of Mod Podge, allow to dry between coats.



4. Once the Mod Podge is dry, using the sandpaper, gently sand the excess napkin off the back of the tile.



5. Add a felt square to each corner. Use the felt provided and cut small, approximately 1/2" squares (4 per tile) to each corner of the back side of the tile using remaining Mod Podge, white glue or hot glue.



6. Use the provided jute to tie them together if you like. This will make a nice gift or simply display on your table if you prefer.
