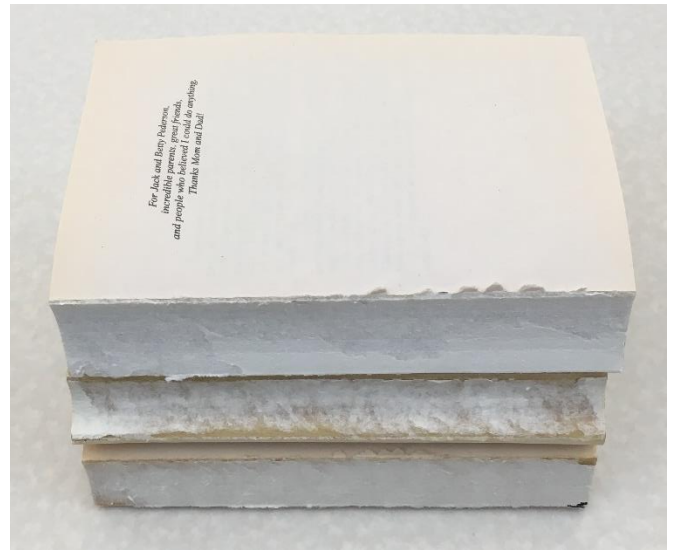


Thankful Book Stack Instructions

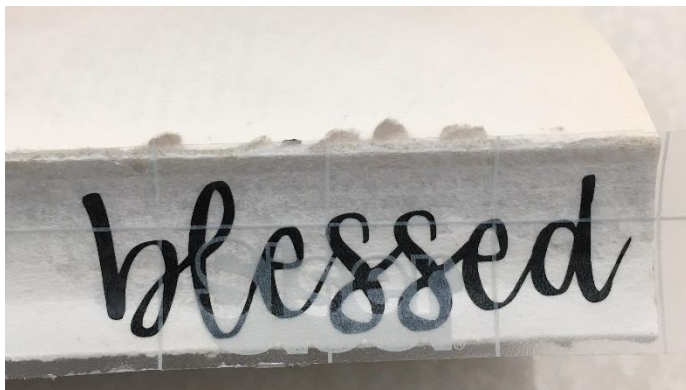
Supplies

Included: Three (3) books, “thankful” sticker, “grateful” sticker, “blessed” sticker, and twine/ribbon

1. Tear the covers off of your 3 books. If you want, you can tear off the first few pages until you get to a blank (or mostly blank) page.
2. Make sure the spines of the books are pretty flat. Tear off any loose bits of paper so the stickers have a nice flat surface to stick to.



3. Take the white backing off of the “thankful” sticker and place the wording on the spine of one of the books. You can place it wherever you’d like, but for my example, I placed the words on the right side of the spine when the book is laying on its back.
4. Press the sticker onto the spine then gently peel off the clear covering.



5. Do that with the “grateful” and “blessed” stickers as well on the other two books.
6. Stack your books in whatever order you’d like.
7. Tie the ribbon or twine around the stack of books, essentially tying the books together. Make sure the bow or knot is on the top (or front) of the top book. If you have twine, wrap it around a few times.



****Optional:** Tie on some fake fall leaves or a small evergreen branch to add a little pizzazz to your stack.
