

Wooden Bunny

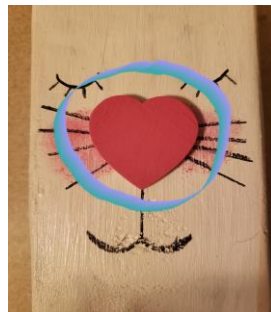


Supplies

Included : Block of wood, wooden heart, wired ribbon, twine, white paint, pink paint, cotton ball

Not Included: Small paint brush, black marker, sand paper (for distressing, if you prefer), hot glue, white glue or staple gun

1. Paint the block of wood on all sides using the supplied white paint. Let dry thoroughly. (If you prefer the distressed look, once it is dry, you can lightly sand the white paint, revealing some of the natural wood.
2. Paint the wooden heart before gluing on the face, using the supplied pink paint (one side is fine). Let dry thoroughly.
3. Paint the cheeks. Using leftover pink and white paint, mix together, gently dab the cotton ball in the paint and “pat” the cheeks onto the face of the bunny.
4. Draw the eyes, whiskers and mouth on the piece of wood. Be as creative as you like.



5. Glue the pink heart on the wood for the nose, positioning as you like.
(use hot glue or white glue)
6. Using the strip of wired ribbon, trace a “bunny ear” shape at each end. Cut out the ear sections at each end, keeping the piece of ribbon in one piece.



7. Cinch the ribbon in the middle of the piece. Tie the twine around the cinch to hold. Either hot glue or staple the knot to the block of wood in the center of the top. Arrange the ears to stand up.
